# EKCC KARATE RULES



## ALL COACHES MUST SIGN THE DECLARATION ON THE ENTRY FORM

ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE IN POSSESSION OF A VALID KARATE LICENCE ON THE DAY. ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED IF THE COMPETITORS' LICENCE NUMBERS AND EXPIRY DATE HAVE BEEN PROVIDED. THERE WILL BE RANDOM LICENCE CHECKS ON THE DAY AND FAILURE TO PRODUCE A VALID LICENCE COULD RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. IT IS A CONDITION OF THE TOURNAMENT INSURANCE COVER THAT ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE PROPERLY LICENSED.

## WUKF BASED RULES WILL APPLY WITH SOME AMENDMENTS KATA COMPETITION

- 1/ There will be two rounds where the top 6 people will go to the final round.  
**IF ONLY 6 IN EVENT ONE ROUND**
- 2/ Novice to 8<sup>TH</sup> Kyu can **REPEAT THE SAME KATA**  
Can only Heian, Pinan & any Basic Kata from their Style **EVENTS- 1 TO 4 & TEAM EVENT 49 & 50. CAN NOT DO ANY ADVANCED KATA (SENTEI OR TOKUI)**
- 3/ However, 5<sup>th</sup> Kyu and above must perform a different kata and  
**CAN DO ANY ADVANCED KATA SENTEI OR TOKUI**
- 4/ Accumulated scores from both rounds will determine 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> places.
- 5/ In the event of a draw Novice to 6<sup>th</sup> Kyu may repeat kata previously performed,  
**EVENTS 1-2-3-4 AND TEAM EVENT 49 – 50, NO ADVANCED KATA (SENTEI OR TOKUI)**  
All others **EVENTS** must perform a kata **NOT** done in previous rounds.  
**EVENTS 15 TO 18A CAN DO ANY ADVANCED KATA SENTEI OR TOKUI**

## KUMITE COMPETITION

- 1/ **Duration:** Junior 15years under **1½ minutes** – Senior 16years over **2 minutes**
- 2/ All events will be Nihon Kumite. Nage techniques will be allowed in Nihon events.
- 3/ Compulsory: Both red and white/blue hand mitts, both red and white belts, gum shield, groin protectors for male over the age of 12. These must be in good clean condition.
- 4/ **Optional protection:** Helmet and groin protectors for under 12 years.  
chest protectors for female's Soft shin pads for all ages.  
**THERE WILL BE 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and joint 3<sup>rd</sup> places will be awarded IN KATA. KUMITE AND TEAM EVENTS**

## REFEREES

### Chief Referee on the day

All Associations are requested to send licensed referees (Association, National Governing Body, WUKF) for Kata and/or Kumite.  
Please provide names in advance, preferably accompanying the registration entry form and indicate Kata/Kumite or both.

Referees are kindly requested to fill in the appropriate section on the entry form with their names, qualifications (if any), and contact details.

- **Lunch refreshments and Payment will be provided for all officials but you must put your name on form.**



## ALL COACHES

1. The named coach is responsible for the behavior of all his/her competitors and any spectator accompanying their competitors. The coach is responsible for obtaining parental or guardian, permission for entry into the event and checking that their competitors have appropriate insurance, through their respective Associations.

2. Any competitor, coach or representative who behaves discourteously to any member of the refereeing panel may cause the immediate disqualification of their competitor and could ultimately lead to disqualification of their whole team.

3. Coaches must ensure that all competitors are entered in their appropriate age (as on date of tournament), grade, height and weight categories. Entries can also be made into but age or belt category above. It may not be possible to change entries on the day

4. Club coaches and competitors must maintain good conduct and etiquette at all times. Only one club coach is permitted on the side lines.

5. Spectators and competitors not in active categories must remain in spectator or warm up areas.

6. The organisers reserve the right to amend the categories to better suit the entry profile. There may be amalgamations of categories if there are not enough entries in the said events as per WUKF rules.

7. All entries and payments **MUST** be submitted by date of deadline. No refunds will be made or withdrawals **ONCE THE FORMS HAVE BEEN PRINTED THURSDAY MORNING** after this day **NO REFUND ALL MUST BE PAID.**

8. **A COMPETITOR CAN NOT ENTER THE ADAPTED KATA IF DO ANY OTHER EVENT**

9. **ANY ENTRIES ON THE DAY MAY BE ENTERTAINED WITH AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF £5.00 PER ENTRY.**



